In Japan, children between the ages of six and fifteen are required by law to attend school.

If your child wishes to enroll in a public school (elementary/junior high school), foreign children are accepted as well as Japanese children.

These ages are very important for children's future so let them have an education.

Tuition and textbooks are free in public elementary and junior high schools.

SCHOOL APPLICATION PROCESS

1 Register your residence in Gamagori at the City Hall, Citizen's Affair Division (1st floor)

You will need to fill in 2 documents;

- · 「転入学通知書」(Enrollment and Student Transfer Form)
- ・「日本語に対するアンケート」 (Japanese Language Proficiency Questionnaire)
- 2 You will have an interview at the Board of Education.

 (6th floor in the City Hall)
- · We will explain about the school you will enroll.
- You can consult us how to be prepared by the enrollment day.
- You will receive information on the Japanese Language Program for New Students and a physical exam for tuberculosis.

IMPORTANT!!

To Students who came from TB-burden Countries

Students who came from one of the high TB-burden countries will need to have a physical exam for tuberculosis (**Chest X-ray**) in the city of Gamagori. (Students who lived in those countries for more than a half year in the past 3 years)

This exam is free of charge and is mandatory. If you will not take it, we cannot allow you to go to school.
